Curriculum Changes

Clinical Practicum Course Changes: Beginning Fall 2009, the A.A.S. Degree in ECED will require only 2 practicum courses instead of 3. The two courses will have new titles and will be 3 credits each:

ECED 2130 Initial Practicum – 3 credits – offered fall and spring semesters

ECED 2160 Final Practicum – 3 credits – offered spring semester only

The AAS Degree will continue to require a maximum of 60 credits.

The Technical Certificate will increase from 22 credits to 23 credits.
