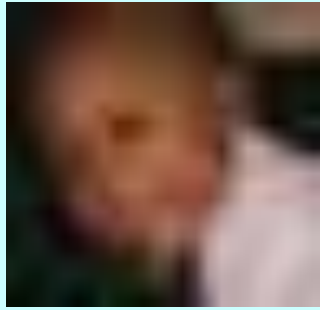

Our 15-point curriculum, designed by **Vimala McClure**, author of *Infant Massage a Handbook for Loving Parents*, will give you the knowledge, experience and confidence necessary to fulfill your role as an **infant massage educator**. During the **three parent-baby classes** which are part of the training, you receive practical experience observing and teaching infant massage.

Certification Process

To earn your Certified Educator of infant Massage (CEIM) status, you need to:

- ❧ Attend the four-day certification training
- ❧ Complete and submit the exam and practicum within 16 weeks following the training

The 4-day course plus completion of the take home exam and practicum qualify for **51.5 Contact Hours** for **Nurses**, **56 CE Hours** for **Massage therapists**, **56 PDH Child Life Specialists** and **5.1 CEUs** for **Occupational Therapists** through AOTA Provider number 6015.
